Confirmation of Learning Disability Diagnosis

Often students come to college with out-of-date, incomplete or inconclusive documentation of their learning challenges. Summer transition students will be referred for fast tracked learning disability assessments. This assessment allows you and your counsellor to develop individualized strategies to maximize your potential.
